Roger Ballentine is the President of Green Strategies Inc., where he advises clients on business strategy, transaction execution, and public policy matters in the energy and environmental arena. Roger previously was a senior member of the White House staff, serving President Bill Clinton as Chairman of the White House Climate Change Task Force and Deputy Assistant to the President for Environmental Initiatives. Prior to being named Deputy Assistant to the President, Mr. Ballentine was Special Assistant to the President for Legislative Affairs, where he focused on energy and environmental issues.

Mr. Ballentine serves on the Boards of Directors of Environmental Power Corporation (NASDAQ:EPG), Perillon Software Inc., ARC China Investments (a European-based investment fund) and on the Advisory Boards of Gridpoint, C3, Stratos Renewables Corporation, Pure Biofuels Corporation and the American Council on Renewable Energy (ACORE) (where he was a founding Board member in 2001). Mr. Ballentine is also a member of the International Advisory Council of the Department of Energy's National Renewable Energy Laboratory.
